

## January "Four patch pinwheel" center: finishes at 6"

### Fabric

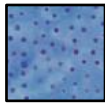


### Color

Yellow

### Cut

Cut 2 - 4" squares



Blue

Cut 2 - 4" squares

### You will also need:



White tone on  
tone background

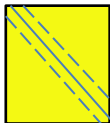
4 - 3 1/2" squares



Flying geese  
Units

4 - Measuring 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" unfinished  
(Use the method of your choice)

### Sewing: Use a scant 1/4" seam



Place a blue and yellow square right sides together. Draw a line from one corner to the opposite diagonal corner. Stitch on either side of this line 1/4".



Cut apart. Press towards the blue triangles. Repeat with the remaining 2 squares, to create a total of 4 half square triangle blocks. Trim to 3 1/2".



Stitch the four squares together, checking the orientation of the pinwheels so that they match the picture. Press.

Measure to make sure it is 6 1/2"



Add flying geese units to two opposite sides of the nine patch.

Press towards the center



Add background squares to the ends of both remaining flying geese units. Press towards the corner squares.



Finally, stitch the remaining flying geese and corner units to the last two sides of your block. Press.

Measure to make sure your block is 12 1/2"
