

September "Economy patch" center: finishes at 6"

Fabric



Color

Pale Yellow

Cut

Cut 2 - 3 7/8" squares.... Sub-cut on the diagonal one time to yield 4 triangles



Orange

Cut 1 - 4 3/4" square

You will also need:



White tone on tone background

4 - 3 1/2" squares



Flying geese Units

4 - Measuring 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" unfinished
(Use the method of your choice)

Sewing: Use a scant 1/4" seam



Stitch yellow triangles to opposite sides of the orange center square. Press towards the yellow.



Stitch the two remaining triangles to the other sides. Press. Measure to make sure it is 6 1/2"

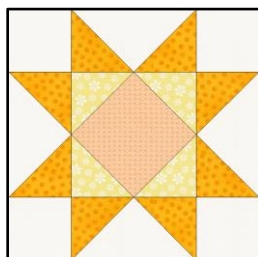


Add flying geese units to two opposite sides of the nine patch.

Press towards the center



Add background squares to the ends of both remaining flying geese units. Press towards the corner squares.



Finally, stitch the remaining flying geese and corner units to the last two sides of your block. Press.

Measure to make sure your block is 12 1/2"
